(Pre-Elementary School Orientation)































Japanese Language Course: "Reading School **Handouts**" for Foreign Parents and Guardians




("Japanese Used in Nursing Care" Course)





Regarding Resident Tax Payments








The fourth payment of the inhabitant tax (special city inhabitant tax and metropolitan inhabitant tax) is due on January 31.

The 13th Gurutto Quiz Rally in Minemachi!


















[Workshop: "Reading Easy Japanese"]

- Free of charge 15 participants (a reservation is required).



- - A reservation is required (accepted by phone or at the library counter)


